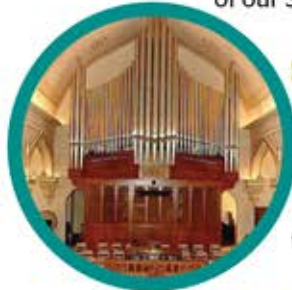
### 67th Annual Christmas at St. Lorenz
