Pastor's Greeting

Song – “*Christ is Risen*”

A Time of Confession and Forgiveness

Confession using Psalm 51

Pastor: (This morning we take time to examine our hearts and confess before God that we have sinned and truly deserve to be cut off from Him forever. God's word tells us we are dead in trespasses and sin. In the moments ahead, I would like for us to reflect on Psalm 51, pause and confess our sins, and with repentance in our hearts, hear a word of assurance from our God.)...

Pastor: ¹ Have mercy on me, O God, according to your unfailing love; according to your great compassion, blot out my transgressions.

All: ² Wash away all my iniquity and cleanse me from my sin.

Pastor: ³ For I know my transgressions, and my sin is always before me.

All: ⁴ Against you, you only, have I sinned and done what is evil in your sight; so you are right in your verdict and justified when you judge.

(Take some time to silently confess your sins)

Pastor: ¹⁰ Create in me a pure heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me.

All: ¹¹ Do not cast me from your presence or take your Holy Spirit from me.

Pastor: ¹² Restore to me the joy of your salvation and grant me a willing spirit, to sustain me.

All: Amen!

Pastor: Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the the Law; being made a curse for us. He bore the punishment we deserve. It is for His sake that God forgives us all our sins. As a called and ordained servant of Christ, I announce to you that your sins are forgiven. In the name of The Father, The Son, and The Holy Spirit. Amen!
