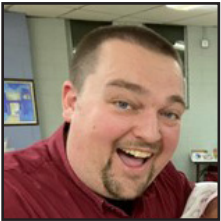

PRE-SCHOOL VBS

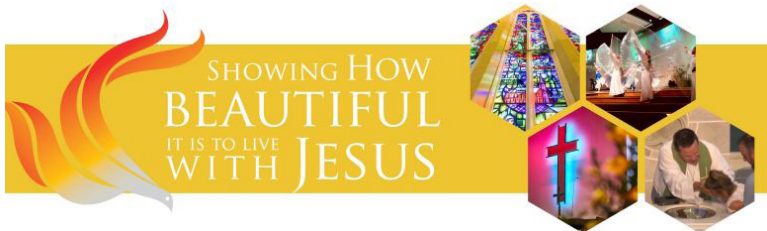

The Lutheran Hour

There are now 1,800+ North America radio stations airing **The Lutheran Hour**, with an average of 1 million listeners each week. In the Saginaw area, it airs at 8:30am on WSAM-1400AM. For you, this schedule may not be a convenient time to hear Rev. Dr. Michael Zeigler, the speaker of *The Lutheran Hour*, proclaim the Gospel message. Good news! *The Lutheran Hour* can also be heard outside of traditional radio: Sunday morning on SiriusXM's Family Talk channel, and on-demand through Spotify, Apple, Google, iHeartRadio, and other streaming services. Many listen on-line at lhm.org, where a rotation of classic broadcasts are featured.

That means anyone can access the program at any hour from anywhere in the world! Signal strength, market availability, and airtimes no longer limit them. The Gospel message may be heard freely, thanks to financial support from the 30 LCMS churches and their members in the Saginaw Valley.
