Church Tours and Tour Guides

Family Ministry

St. Lorenz Family Ministry aims to help parents understand the various phases of their child's development, prepare for what may be next, and learn to apply this knowledge to the unique makeup of each child. Also, we want to help them face common issues of parenting and establish healthy, Christ-centered habits in family life. We share resources with school families and also host several Family Faith Events in many grades throughout the school year.



Funeral Luncheon

The funeral luncheon ministry means more than simply serving a catered meal to attendees after a funeral. Our volunteers create a warm, compassionate environment where families and friends can share memories and relax while enjoying a delicious meal. Ministry volunteers support this effort by contributing prepared dishes, arranging and setting the tables, serving the meal, or cleaning up afterwards.



Grief Share

GriefShare is a 13-week video-based support group for those that have lost a loved one. St. Lorenz's GriefShare groups are held at select times during the year. They are facilitated by the Pastoral Care Pastor or a team of caring individuals.

CONGREGATIONAL MINISTRIES

Heritage Committee

The Heritage Committee is interested in locating and receiving historical papers, pictures, and artifacts pertaining to the history of St. Lorenz congregation. We welcome members interested in the history of St. Lorenz, those that like to do historical research, design and set-up of displays, presentation of historical programs, and write historical news articles. We also rely on members for maintenance of historical sites and structures.



Office Volunteers

The goals of the volunteers are to assist the office staff that support the functions of the church and school. All the needs would not be able to be accomplished without the dedication of our volunteers.



Parents of College Students

What an easy way to let our college students know we're thinking about them! We pray for students, and mail small "goodie" boxes to college students. We know that the assault on Christian values is strong on college campuses, so our Christian Citizenship Ministry has purchased "Answers in Genesis" booklets that cover 23 key areas where God's truth is being compromised. We include these in mailings to help our young people spot the lies they may be hearing. Packing the boxes is fun and takes little time. Join us!



Prayer Committee

The Prayer Committee's focus is to make St. Lorenz known as a House of Prayer. They encourage the use of prayer in families, meetings, classes, and the community ensuring they weave prayer throughout the fabric of all they do. The committee meets once a month for discussion and planning. A good place to meditate is along the Prayer Trail in our Churchgrove woods. There are prayers, art work and benches along the way.

We make hundreds of quilts every year for Orphan Grain Train Sebewaing, Underground Railroad Saginaw, and Franklin Avenue Mission Flint, knowing that they will comfort someone we will never meet. LWML Bookstore

Volunteers of the St. Lorenz LWML sell cards, books, Bibles, gifts, etc., to congregation members and visitors. We have two locations, in the church basement and at the church office across from the church library. All proceeds go to missions through LWML mites.



MOPS (Mothers of Preschoolers)

We believe in the simple but revolutionary idea that remarkable things happen when moms come together, face to face. That's why we rally women to come together in their own neighborhoods and help each other through this thing called motherhood, one gathering at a time.



St. Lorenz Women's Conference

The goal of the St. Lorenz Women's Conference is to inspire and empower women to know their Savior at a deeper and more personal level. We hope to advance the Kingdom of Christ and show others how beautiful it is to live with Jesus. To this end, we host a one-day women's Bible conference in the Worship & Event Center each January. 




Lutheran Laymen's League




BIBLE STUDY MINISTRIES








Altar Guild

This group ensures that candles are prepared for worship services, and ensures that the correct paraments adorn the chancel area of the church. Gowns for the pastors and liturgists are washed & pressed. They also assist in keeping the area clean.



Church Banners

Banners are made with designs proposed for the various themes and seasons of the church year. As the seasons change, so do the banners. Because these banners and other paraments are not sewn, they are of cut-and-paste type, no real artistic/sewing skills are required. Four parament hangar hooks are used, as well as banner poles for display.

WORSHIP-RELATED MINISTRIES

Church Beautification

The work done by this ministry is visible throughout the year including the following interior and exterior displays: Christmas altar display, garland, Christmas trees; "Joy," "Peace," and manger scene outside the front of the church; Easter altar display, sunrise lighting, narthex Easter cross, tomb and crosses set up outside; Advent wreath (interior and exterior). As well, summer flowers are planted in May and tended through October.



Communion Assistants

Communion assistants at the Church and the Worship Center are made up of some called workers as well as lay leaders. The assistants are used to help the pastors in distributing Communion to the members. These are volunteer positions managed through the church office for scheduling.



Greeters

Greeters welcome worship attendees before the service with friendly greetings in both the traditional and Connect services and answer any questions guests may have. If interested in serving the Lord in this way, please contact the pastor's administrative secretary.



Service Coordinator

For both the Connect and Traditional services duties include preparing communion trays, preparing the baptismal font for baptisms and ensuring that everything runs smoothly during services. In addition, for the traditional services, coordinators acolyte and assist ushers if necessary with the offering.

Tech and Media Teams

In our Connect service, tech and media volunteers assist with lighting, sound, and video to enhance the worship service and also manage the live broadcasting. In our Traditional service, the media team runs various cameras, operates the media control desk, and ensures the service is broadcasted live.



Ushers

Ushers assist at worship services by greeting members and guests, ushering members to communion and assisting in case of emergencies. In the traditional services ushers also hand out bulletins and worship folders to those that request them as well as collect the offering.



Connect Service Volunteers


Volunteers for our Connect services at our Worship & Event Center do a variety of activities including working the coffee bar, attending the information desk and greeting attendees.


Adult Choirs

AbleLight/Bethesda Thrift Shop

AbleLight's Saginaw Thrift Shop is one of 20 stores across the country that are owned and operated by AbleLight Lutheran Communities. All profits support AbleLight. The stores are run primarily by volunteers from many churches. St. Lorenz volunteers typically work the first Friday of each month as cashiers, sorters, and general retail positions. It's a fun way to help while getting to know others.



Care-A-Van

We are able to eliminate the stress of trying to find affordable rides for important appointments with our Care-A-Van ministry. We serve members of the congregation and community who need transportation to and from worship, medical appointments, and other important appointments. We are in need of volunteers who have a valid driver's license, dependable transportation, can pass a criminal background check, and are willing to transport members without compensation within Saginaw County.





Caring Tree

This ministry provides assistance at Christmas time to individuals and families who are facing a time of financial difficulty. Offering gifts, some essential items, and opportunities for growth and change helps others in moving past a difficult time.



Christian Citizenship Ministry

CCM is a 360° ministry, reflecting a holistic approach to addressing contemporary public policy issues. CCM is actively looking for dedicated Christians who love their nation and desire to promote a culture that respects religious freedom, the sanctity of human life at all stages, and God's design for marriage and family. We occasionally offer financial assistance to high school students wishing to attend Worldview Academy offered during summers. We currently have more project opportunities than volunteers so your participation is needed.



Clothesline Thrift Store

We take donated clothing and sort, display, and sell them at quite reasonable prices. All proceeds go to various charities. All help is volunteer, and volunteers sign up to work at their convenience for 3.5 hour shifts either mornings or afternoons. The store hours are Monday through Saturday 11:00 AM - 2:00 PM. Closed Sundays.



Community Blood Drives

Our faithful volunteers help make each blood drive we host run smoothly and offer opportunities to share the love of Jesus to those who donate. Help us make every year a great year for all those in need of life saving donations!

Community Service Ministry

We provide support for individuals facing financial difficulty, primarily members of St. Lorenz, the 48734 zip code, and the immediate surrounding communities. This support includes financial guidance for budgeting and debt reduction. We may also offer limited and short term financial assistance. Services do not include greater emergency needs such as homeless shelter/housing, next day utility shutoff, etc.



CrossRoads Counseling

CrossRoads Counseling Ministries is a Christcentered ministry which offers professional counseling and educational services to anyone and is supported by many Christian churches from the area. Some of their resources include Stephen Ministers, Prayer Partners, and financial assistance for counseling through the Good Samaritan Support Program.



Diaper and Wipe Drive

Diaper and Wipe Drives are held in the months of May (in honor of Mother's Day) and January (Sanctity of Life month). Assorted sizes of diapers and wipes can be dropped off at the Sanctuary in the Church Parlor at the designated table, Church Office reception desk, Monday through Friday, and on Sunday mornings at the Worship and Event Center. Donations have been going to LifeClinic Community Resource Center in Saginaw.



Divorce Care

Divorced or separated? Find help, hope, and healing with Divorce Care. Meetings take place online on Thursdays from March 11th - June 3rd from 6:00 PM to 8:00pm. You can join at any time! Visit www.divorcecare.org and check out the 13-week seminar/support group. We also offer in person sessions at various times during the year.





Flint Mission Network/Franklin Avenue Mission

St. Lorenz, along with other area congregations, assist the members of the Flint community by providing a meal and a Bible Study. Volunteers are needed to help serve our neighbors at the Franklin Avenue Mission Diner on Tuesday and Thursday afternoons on specific dates. Food preparers, servers, greeters, cooks, and dishwashers are greatly appreciated. Isaiah 58:10 says, "Feed the hungry and help those in trouble. Then your light will shine out from the darkness, and the darkness around you will be as bright as day."



German Outreach and Worship Ministry

Our focus is on using the German language as an outreach to both German speakers and learners, as well as those interested in the culture. Our group coordinates a monthly German worship service at St. Lorenz Church, and works with various other groups and individuals where the German language is involved. Our group meets monthly for discussion and planning. We are always looking for new members to help with projects and bring new ideas.



Mission Festival

Mission Fest is an opportunity to share with our congregation and community the local, national, and international missions that we support. It is typically held outdoors on the 4th Sunday of August each year in the St. Lorenz Churchgrove. It includes a BBQ meal, as well as children's games and inflatables with activities to teach them about mission work. Leading up to event, the congregation is asked to help provide goods and supplies for a local charity.



Mission Outreach Ministry

This ministry, a portion of the former Board of Missions and Evangelism, actively focuses on engaging people in mission activities and service projects locally, nationally and internationally since 2007. The ministry supports individual and group involvement at the Flint Mission Network, in Youth mission trips, and through international mission trips. They also seek opportunities to support involvement in mission trips by providing scholarships, and encouragement to those who request financial support. Every year, group members are involved in developing, leading or participating in two or three international mission trips to Central America and other global locations.

National Day of Prayer

The National Day of Prayer is the first Thursday in May. We join other Christians in front of City Hall around noon and pray for our country and its governmental leaders. Prayers and songs are offered collectively, followed by small group prayers. We are thankful to live in a land where we have the freedom and privilege to do so! Join us! You can help us get the word out with a yard sign on your lawn the week prior. We'll put the sign in your lawn and pick it up afterward.



Prayer Shawl Ministry

We make blankets for the baptismal chests, chemo hats, socks and mittens, hats for newborns, and helmet liners for soldiers. As each item is created, the person stitching it says prayers for its recipient; sometimes without knowing who it will eventually go to! We meet every Tuesday from 1:30-3:30 PM at The Rock to knit, crochet, and have good conversations. Anyone is welcome; and if you need to learn how to knit or crochet, we can teach you! Yarn donations can be dropped off at the church office.



Short Term Mission Trips

We partner with Mission Opportunities Short Term (MOST Ministries), a Recognized Service Organization of the LCMS. Our ministry goal is to assist Missouri Synod affiliated Lutheran congregations in Central America with Gospel outreach to the local community. Helping these congregations be the "Hands of Christ" in their community gives them greater opportunity to present the "Heart of Christ" to their neighbors.



SORT (Sally's Organized Recycling/Trash)

Our purpose: 1) Provide and update correct information on curbside recycling, 2) Collect items for the STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Math) programs in local schools, and 3) Provide information on local charities that accept and distribute household items no longer needed. The people that have these items are happy to know where they can dispose of them and that they'll be put to good use rather than winding up in landfills and the people receiving the items will have a chance at starting a new life.





WEC Special Events Ministry

This team works to plan and coordinate special events that will glorify God by supporting and building up faith, encouraging fellowship, reaching out to our community, and providing entertaining, inspiring and Biblical worldview experiences. Among other events, we have been blessed to host speaker/comedian Mark Gungor, The Gettys, The Skit Guys, Miss America with Girls of Grace, Cloverton and Leanna Crawford with our Girls of Grace, and Sidewalk Prophets.
